

Rules and Regulations Fagerhaug International School

We want to:

- Show respect towards classmates, employees and others (in language, behavior and attitude – both in school and in route to school)
- Show respect towards the teaching (by keeping a peaceful working environment, treating equipment in a respectful manner, by coming precise and participating by ability.
- Always respect the current rules and regulations for the outdoor area (see class rules).
- Respect that different outdoor activities are done in different zones on the playground.
- Keep the school areas neat, clean and tidy.
- Respect that the teaching area is only open when a teacher is present.
- Take responsibility for your own valuables (for example money, phones and music players)

We understand:

- Violence, theft, racism, exclusion, threats, bullying, harsh language and harassment are forbidden.
- Use and storage of substances such as tobacco products are forbidden.
- Use of energy drinks is not allowed.
- Cheating and truancy can affect the assessment of a subject area or behavioral expectations.
- Phones are to be used in accordance with the rules.
 - o Students in 1st to 6th grade (if a phone is brought to school) must have the phone turned off in their school bag.
 - o Students in 7th to 10th grade must store their phone in a phone hotel in the classroom.
 - o Students in 7th to 10th grade can, at the discretion of the teacher, telephones can be used.
- We are only permitted to be on school grounds during school hours.
- Weapons and objects that are illegal or can cause injuries are forbidden and must stay home.

We know that violations of these rules and regulations:

- Can lead to a written warning, a phone call or letter to guardian
- Can lead to cleaning or doing repair work.
- Can lead to financial compensation, jf. *Skadeerstatningsloven*
- Can lead to seizure of contents.
- Can lead to detention during break time, before or after school, in connection to conversations with teachers/principal or execution of mandatory tasks
- Can lead to a lower evaluation in connection to behavioral expectations
- Can lead to suspension: For students 1st – 7th grade for one hour or for the rest of the day. For students 8th – 10th grade expulsion can be up to 3 days, jf. *Privatskoleloven* 3 -10. Expulsion is made on an individual basis by the school, jf. *Forvaltningsloven* 2 b, and can affect jf *Forvaltningsloven*. Kap. VI.
